Delivery and registration of your artwork entries for the *Summer Annual* will be substituted for the business of the Artists' League meeting for MAY.

Summer Annual Exhibition Dates: May 15—July 2, 2015

Theme: A Beautiful Idea. Entries may be any size in any medium.

Delivery: Deliver works for jurying (or have a friend deliver them for you) Tuesday May 5th, 7 - 9 pm or Wednesday, May 6th, 12 - 4 pm. Works will not be accepted outside those hours. You must tag works with the labels at the bottom of each entry form.

Eligibility: You must be a League member to enter. If you are not a current member, you can join or update your dues at the time you deliver your works. Dues are \$15. Checks for membership must be made out to the **FSU Foundation**. Work will only be accepted if the artist is a member (that is, dues have been paid by the time the work is entered).

Entry Fee: A fee of \$10 will be charged for entering up to 3 works for the Artists' League Annual. For each additional work, up to 6 works, an additional \$1.00 will be charged. Checks for this fee must be made out to **Artists' League**.

Juror: **Barbara Cohenour, the art events coordinator for Tallahassee Community College.** Date for jurying: Friday, May 8th. A list of accepted works will not be ready until Monday, May 11th at noon. You may contact the Museum after noon on the 11th to find out which works have been selected (645-4681).

Awards: Cash awards for 1st (\$150) and 2nd (\$100), as well as two Honorable Mentions (\$40 each) will also be decided by the juror. The Professional Development Award will be announced. These will be posted on opening night.

Images for Publicity: If so desired, please submit digital images to Teri Abstein @ tabstein@fsu.edu by the end of the submission window on May 6th.

Pick-up of Works Not Selected by the Juror:

Monday, May 11th through Friday, May 15th, hours 12 - 4 pm. If you cannot pick up work, please arrange for a friend/representative to pick up the work. Works cannot be picked up during the reception.

Insurance: Coverage on those works selected begins with the date of the exhibition. Works not selected will not be insured.

Opening and Reception: The exhibition will open on Friday, May 15th with the reception scheduled for 6 – 8 pm. The Museum will supply punch, ice, and cups. Artists' League members are asked to bring party-type finger food.

Hours: The exhibition extends from May 15th through July 2nd with hours Monday through Friday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm. Closed weekends and national holidays.

A **list of artworks** with their selling prices will be provided for visitors to the Museum. The Museum will not take a commission if an artwork is sold. When work is submitted for entry to the exhibition it is understood that the Museum will provide the artist's or gallery representative's phone number to any potential buyer so that all transactions take place between the buyer and the artist or artist's representative. For those artists who wish for buyers to make contact with a gallery, please provide the gallery number to the Museum.

End of the Exhibition: The schedule for pick up of works will extend during the week following the exhibition, from July 6 - 10. Pick up of works will occur from 12 - 4 pm each day. The insurance will expire at the end of that week.

***A mail art show will occur in tandem with the *Summer Annual*. League members may enter works in the mail art show with current League membership and at least one entry in the Summer Annual. See separate prospectus for details.

There is NO general Artists' League meeting for May. Instead, deliveries of entries for the Summer Annual will be substituted.
