Woman in Gold,

a movie starring Helen Mirren and Ryan Reynolds, about the masterpiece by Gustave Klimt, *Portrait of Adele Bloch-Bauer*, the *Woman in Gold*

This film chronicles the efforts of Maria Altman and her lawyer, Randy Schoenberg (played by Helen Mirren and Ryan Reynolds, below), to retrieve paintings from the Austrian government, long after they had been abcsonded from Maria's family during World War II, particularly the *Woman in Gold*, a portrait

of Maria's Aunt Adele by Gustav Klimt. After years



of proceedings, including a ruling by the US Supreme Court in 2004, the paintings were finally shipped to Maria's adopted city of Los Angeles several years later. The work became part of the museum collection of the Neue Galerie in New York City in 2006 and has been on display there ever since.



This 1907 portrait which took 3 years to complete (above, oil, silver and gold on canvas, 54" x 54"), one of two paintings of Aunt Adele, is considered a masterpiece of Klimt's "Golden Phase." Gustav Klimt was part of the Vienna Secession, an art movement that rejected traditional painting modes.
