Bragging Rites: Professional Development Award Winners

Program: 7:35 - 9:00 pm

Speakers: Terrie Corbett (encaustic and kiln-fired glass; enamel on copper) and Ramona Abernathy-Paine (weaving). These recipients will discuss their work and explain the projects for which they received their awards.

Terrie Corbett, a long-time League member as well as developer and coordinator of the League shows at

the top of the Capitol, is known for her expressive images that she applies to an unexpected support – a glass or copper canvas. Her goal is to convey emotion and energy though her process is complicated and may incorporate techniques like chemical or sandblast etching. For her, the process inherently holds surprises which she deems “the challenge and the reward.”

Ramona Abernathy-Paine, also a long-time League member, is known for her colorful weaving. She likes the way color interacts with structure and pushes the boundaries of her process to create weavings that perform functionally or sculpturally. She uses mostly natural fibers since the medium reaches back into the millennia. Additionally she “wants to advance ancient skills so future generations will

be able to weave.” She teaches all levels at workshops, conferences, and in her studio in Tallahassee.
