Hilary Eddy Stipelman (seen at left), the Director of Outreach and Exhibitions at the Anne Frank Center in New York City, will give a tour of the

FSU MoFA exhibition, Anne Frank, A History for Today. She manages all traveling exhibitions for the Center throughout the United States and Canada. In addition she directs the educational programming for these exhibitions. The Anne Frank Center shows facsimiles of Anne's diary, family photos, and Holocaust artifacts, but the Center also mounts exhibitions by artists on related themes from across the globe. The Anne Frank Center in NYC holds close ties with the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, a museum that attracts nearly a million visitors a year.



The exhibition, *Anne Frank*, A *History for Today*, meshes photos from Anne Frank's life, photos of the time in which she lived, as well as text from her diary. Anne wrote her diary while she and her family were hiding from the Nazis. Her family was betrayed and arrested in 1944 by a still unidentified person.
