* Speaker: Hilary Eddy Stipelman, Director of Outreach and Exhibitions at the Anne Frank Center in New York City. She will talk about the exhibition, Anne Frank, A History for Today. She manages all traveling exhibitions for the Center throughout the US and Canada. She also directs the educational programming for these exhibitions.

The exhibition meshes photos from Anne Frank's life, text from her diary, as well as contextual photos. Anne wrote her diary while she and her family were hiding from the Nazis. Her family was betrayed and arrested in 1944 by a still unidentified person. The Anne Frank Center shows facsimiles of Anne's diary, family photos, and Holocaust artifacts, but the Center also mounts exhibitions by artists on related themes from across the globe. The Center holds close ties with the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, a museum that attracts nearly a million visitors a year.
