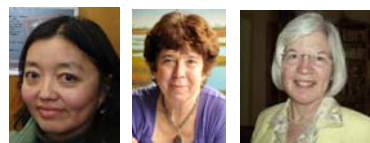

**Panel:** Sara Chang, Jennifer Clinard, Mary Sterner Lawson, Barbara Psimas, and Carrie Ann Baade.

Four of the panelists are League artists who have produced portraits, although they may be known for other types of work. **Sara Chang** is known for her photography and digital compositions often based on people in her everyday life. **Jennifer Clinard**, a former California scenic, mural, and film set artist, is now frequently known for her Florida landscapes. **Mary Sterner Lawson**, a former English professor at Albany State University, is now known for her writing as well as genre sketches of life in the Tallahassee/North Florida area. **Barbara Psimas** is most known for her luminous watercolors of koi fish as well as her images of madonnas. The one portraitee on the panel, the subject of a painting by Barbara Psimas, is **Carrie Ann Baade**. Baade is an Associate Professor of Painting and Drawing at FSU. Her own images are fantastical referencing imagery from the Renaissance and Baroque art historical periods.
