<u>Members voted</u> for this year's priorities/projects including exhibits, community service and other projects. *Kent Griffin* and *Mark Fletcher* counted the votes.

Note: The votes had an overwhelming majority for first and second place. There was no need for any tie-breaker voting. Even so, we had a discussion by members present on many pros and cons of each issue raised.

Our general membership usually chooses only 2 major projects beyond the work already being accomplished by our hard-working "chair committees".

Members voted for the following priorities:

1. "Digital/Point and Click" workshop featuring the phone camera as an artistic tool Workshop with Todd Bertolet, a photography professor at famuhammyfstop@yahoo.com

Tentatively, a third Tuesday in 2016-2017 for the workshop has been discussed. But the date is TBA.

- 2. Exhibits. Two exhibits received equal number of votes: TCC and the N FL Community College in Madison. After open discussion it was decided that we don't need two showings of the same work in Tallahassee in the same year, so we will pursue the exhibit in Madison, FL.
- 3. Special category: The Artists' League will sponsor/support arts and students in the community by giving money/supplies to a Leon County Public School Art teacher whose school/program is under-funded (Marcia Meale might be Dr. Viki's contact person).
