Deadline to deliver artwork to MoFA: May 1, 2017

Who is eligible to enter:

- All current and retired K-12 art educators in Leon and surrounding counties. Includes: Gadsden, Jefferson, and Wakulla.

Submission Guidelines:

- Artwork should have been made within the last 5-6 years
- Larger pieces and installations or collaborations are encouraged
- Up to three pieces per person
- No theme
- Work should be ready to hang or show
- Artwork submissions should also include an artist statement and a statement of pedagogy

Entry fee:
