Guidelines for exhibition are:

- Your AL membership must be up-to-date
- Artwork must not have been shown at the Capitol, previously
- ____Artwork must not have been shown in the Summer/Salon Annual for 2016, 2017, or 2018
- Artwork must not have been shown in the Walmsley Gallery or any Artists' League related Exhibition for 2016, 2017, 2018
- __You must comply with the **requirements** from the **Division of Cultural Affairs** on page two of this application

Application Requirements and Check List :

- 1. Two dimensional works should be framed and equipped with wire or hangers. Labels should be attached to the back of all artworks. The Division reserves the right to exclude from the exhibit any artworks that are not properly prepared for installation (NO exceptions will be made)
- 2. Installations requiring electricity or water may *not be accepted*. Works determined by the Division to present potential physical danger to the viewer will not be displayed.
- 3. Also: the Division is not responsible for packing artwork upon dismantling of the exhibit and is not obligated to provide any packing materials . . . The division reserves the right not to display any work deemed inappropriate for public viewing. (i.e. nudity, violence, and religious iconography)
- 4. Unless the Division of Cultural Affairs is notified in writing to the contrary, it is understood that the artwork on the loan may be reproduced for all standard purposes including, methods involving photographic, electronic and mechanical means, and displaying, distributing and transmitting such reproduction or images to the general public. Reproductions and transmissions may be released through media such as catalogues, books, brochures, world wide web, postcards, posters, invitations, magazines, newspaper, journals, films, television, slides, negatives, and prints.
- 5. All pieces will remain in place for the full duration of the exhibition. Only the Division may cancel for cause.
