#### Leslie Puckett:

Leslie Puckett graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Art Education from FSU and then worked for State Law Enforcement several years. The following decade she studied and taught calligraphy, its history, techniques and design. After returning to FSU for a Masters Degree in Art Education, Studio Art and Art Administration Leslie worked with LeMoyne Art Foundation as Education Director, 621 Gallery as Gallery Director, COCA as Art in Public Places Coordinator and currently with Tallahassee Senior Center as Art Program Coordinator. She exhibits her collage and mixed media artwork in various regional venues.

#### **Artist Statement:**

I love the way that many artists look at everyday items or issues and show them in another way or from a different perspective. Through studying calligraphy I have enjoyed learning the history/development of writing and communication of ideas through pictures and symbols. I like old stories, myths and artifacts from other cultures and try to understand their view of the world and incorporate bits of those stories and characters into my own world, into poems and artwork. I like going to art galleries and junk stores, looking through books and magazines, and seeing the possibilities of using stuff in a different way to create another way of seeing it. Sometimes, I feel my head is going to explode from the wild mixture churning away in there.

# We'll work on two styles of collage. Supplies to bring:

Scissors (little sharp ones if you have them, regular scissors will do if you don't), glue stick, a jar to hold 6 oz of glue, PVA glue (polyvinyl acetate i.e. Elmers Glue-All, I'll have some to share if you don't have any), a cheap Bristol flat brush ¼ - 3/8" to apply glue, some inexpensive bond paper or newsprint paper to use as scrap paper when using glue stick on small pieces. You can also bring a couple of magazines to use, cut up and share, that have pages of some weight like National Geographic or Vanity Fair, not lightweight like NY Times magazine or Rolling Stones weight.
