32nd Summer Annual Exhibition Dates: June 22 - July 21, 2018



Design: Bill Humphries

Theme: "Global Warning." Entries may be any size in any medium and any style (from total abstraction to photo realism), subject matter or content may vary greatly – as long as the content or subject matter match the title in some way. Only original work will be accepted; no giclees.

Delivery: Deliver works for jurying (or have a friend deliver them for you) Tuesday June 5, 7:00 - 9:00 pm or Wednesday, June 6, 12:00 - 4:00 pm. Works will not be accepted outside those hours. You must tag works with the labels given to you when you deliver your artwork to the Museum.

Eligibility: You must be a League member to enter. If you are not a current member, you can join or update your dues at the time you deliver your works. Dues are \$15. Checks for membership must be made out to the **FSU Foundation**. Work will only be accepted if the artist is a member (that is, dues have been paid by the time the work is entered).

Entry Fee: A fee of \$15 will be charged for entering up to 3 works for the Artists' League Annual. For each additional work, up to 6 works, an additional \$5.00 will be charged. Checks for this fee must be made out to a different account, the **FSU MoFA Artists' League**.

Juror: Brinda Pamulapati, Owner/Director of the Venvi Gallery on Park Avenue in Tallahassee will serve as juror. She is a painter herself, but she also represents artists such as Julie Bowland, Ray Burggraf, Leon Hicks, Mark Messersmith and Mary Stewart.

Date for jurying and notification: The date for jurying: Friday, June 8. A list of accepted works will not be ready until Tuesday, June 12 at 4:00 pm. You may contact the League Liaison from 4:00 to 5:00 pm on Tuesday, June 12 or on Wednesday, June 13 to find out which works have been selected (850-645-4681).

Awards: \$1500 + in cash awards for 1st, 2nd, Honorable Mention, as well as an Emerging Artist Award to be decided by the juror. The Emerging Artist Award will be given to a person who has practiced as an artist for less than five years. Juror's Mentions (not monetary, but suitable for a resume or vita) will be given to the following categories: painting, drawing, sculpture, printmaking/digital, photography, and fine crafts. The Professional Development Award(s) will be announced. All awards will be posted on opening day.

Images for Publicity: If so desired, please submit labeled digital images with your artwork on Tuesday, June 5 or Wednesday, June 6. These images will not be returned to you since publications as a general rule do not return them.

Pick-up of Works Not Selected by the Juror:

Tuesday, June 12 through Friday, June 15, hours 12:00 - 4:00 pm. If you cannot pick up work, please arrange for a friend/representative to pick up the work. Works cannot be picked up during the reception.

Insurance: Coverage on those works selected begins with the date of the exhibition. Works not selected will not be insured.

Opening and Reception: The exhibition will open on Friday, June 22 with the reception scheduled for 6:00 - 8:00 pm. The Museum will supply punch, ice, and cups. Artists' League members are asked to bring party-type finger food. Due to recent University events, alcohol cannot be served without an insured, licensed bartender.

Hours: Exhibition extends from June 22 through July 21 with hours Monday through Friday 9:00 am - 4:00 pm, Saturday hours 1:00 to 4:00 pm, and closed national holidays.

No Art Commission: A list of artworks with their selling prices will be provided for visitors to the Museum. The Museum will not take a commission if an artwork is sold. When work is submitted for entry to the exhibition it is understood the Museum will provide the artist's or gallery representative's phone number to any potential buyer so that all transactions take place between the buyer and the artist or artist's representative. For those artists who wish for buyers to make contact with a gallery, please provide the gallery number to the Museum.

End of the Exhibition Pick Up: Pick up of works will extend during the week following the exhibition, July 23 - 27. Pick up of works will occur from 12:00 - 4:00 pm each day. The insurance will expire at the end of that week.
